2. **profile description:** 2-3 sentences about your own person

We encourage multi-media and innovative approaches to blog design - from graphic novels, photo essays, soundscapes to drawings or collaborative writing, much is possible.

- Please refrain from footnotes and use endnotes only if really necessary
- Don't forget the bibliography!

- Mark placement requests in the body text (e.g. 'Image 1: Title. Source: XVA')
- Please send images separately and not as part of the Word document to be submitted (since Word compresses images heavily).
- Send larger media simply with <https://wetransfer.com/>
